The **New Farms for New Americans (NFNA)** mission is to empower refugees and immigrants to grow their own food and continue the agricultural traditions practiced in their homelands by cultivating culturally important produce. The New Farms for New Americans CSA is the social enterprise part of the NFNA program. Farmers in this program grow food using *organic* methods and with a concern for sustainable practices.

What we offer: Our CSA season is 16 weeks from June through October. (Beginning and end dates vary depending on weather.) A CSA share feeds a family of four and includes a bounty of seasonal Vermont vegetables. If you choose the CSA with prepared food, each share will include a sample of a specialty ethnic food familiar to our farmers. (The prepared food option is not made with 100% organic ingredients.)
