Options for participation include:

- **GIFT & GIFT CARDS:** Since 1988, Share Christmas sponsors have provided gifts for hundreds of children and disabled adults from local low-income families. In addition to those helped through the church, we partner with Burlington’s Howard Center which provides services for households with family members with developmental disabilities and/or emotional and behavioral problems. The Howard Center programs include prevention, assessment, treatment, support and educational services. **And/or**
- **CHRISTMAS DINNER BOX:** Christmas dinner grocery donations collected through SHARE CHRISTMAS will be given to families living in poverty including those helped through church, JUMP & the Chittenden Emergency Food Shelf. **And/or**
- **FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS:** *Share Christmas* financial **donations are welcome and needed throughout November and December.** We use the funds to purchase food and gift cards for families and work to stretch donations often getting great deals on fun practical gifts for children and adults served by our local partners programs. For example, \$50 will buy new warm socks for 100 children or help stop a utility shut-off; \$60 will help us purchase needed food or gifts for local families in need; \$75 will provide new school supplies for 50 children. Every donation will be put to great use!

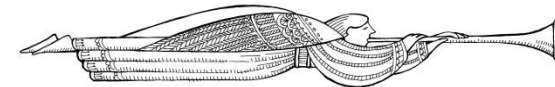
