One: Open your hearts to the One sets us free! All: We open our hearts to you, O God!

One: Let us give thanks to the source of all relationship!

All: It is right to give our thanks and praise!

#### **WORDS OF INSTITUTION**

All: Name struggles and burdens now. If we speak at the same time as one another – that's fine!

One: Pour out your Spirit of Joy as we give thanks in taking this bread and cup and remember all who bring laughter to our days, and warmth to our hearts in this season.

All: Name joys now. If we speak at the same time as one another – that's fine!

One: This we pray,

All: God who knits us all together, we give you thanks.

One: [....] as we pray together now, using the prayer Jesus taught us:

#### THE LORD'S PRAYER

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors, and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. Amen.

#### **SHARING OF THE ELEMENTS**

The bread will come to you first, and you are invited to take a piece and hold it until all are served. We will eat together as a sign of our unity in Christ. The cup will come next, and you are invited to drink your cup as it arrives, as a sign of our individual relationships with our Creator.
